INITIAL ONE OF THE GRADUATION CHOICES ABOVE

- * Most private colleges and other state colleges will accept UC/CSU entrance requirements.
- * UC/CSU requires a minimum of 15 a-g units and 11 must be taken by end of junior year.
- * UC recommends a total of 18 a-g units. Students must take one year of a-g VAPA and 2 years of a-g language.
- * **Graduation for UC/CSU and college-bound students will require approximately 240 units.**
