_____ Attendance at weekly (every 5 school days) face-to-face meetings with the summer ES for four (4) meetings. Failure meet with the ES on a weekly basis or failure to complete the required assignments and turn in all work completed that week will result in the student being dropped from the summer school program. *(Note: If this occurs, it will not affect the student's regular school year enrollment.)*

_____ High school students must attempt 10 credits in summer school (except for a 12th grade student who is finishing up credits to graduate—less will be considered).

_____ All students who have failed a portion of CAHSEE must agree to complete intensive CAHSEE prep, which may include classes to attend, specific materials to complete, etc.

_____ All students who have failed a portion of CAHSEE must agree to attempt CAHSEE at the summer administration on July 26 and 27, 2011. (Only students enrolled in summer school may attend this test administration.)

_____ Community College courses may not be taken concurrently with summer school, unless permission is obtained from the Guidance Counselor.

_____ I understand that there is no separate instructional funding for summer school courses. Any books/materials used for summer school courses must be purchased with the student's 2011 instructional funds.
